

A synopsis of the August 4, 2009 Missouri Transportation Finance Corporation (MTFC) Meeting

## **Summary of Program Activity**

- □ Four loans were approved totaling \$11,479,440.
- □ As of August 4, 2009, MTFC has approximately \$7.1 million available to loan.

### Loans Approved

City of Trenton - \$382,000 to construct turn lanes and upgrade Route 65 for the new hospital and college campuses.

City of Lexington - \$80,000 to resurface Route 224 with asphalt.

St. Charles County - \$10,000,000 for Phase II of Route 364 (Page Avenue) from Central School Road to Mid Rivers Mall Drive.

City of Waynesville - \$1,017,440 to relocate the GW Lane Outer Road that currently runs parallel to I-44.

# **Looking Ahead**

The MTFC's next meeting is scheduled for October 6, 2009. The deadline to apply is August 20, 2009.

#### Did You Know?

The Missouri state highway system owns and maintains 10,249 bridges. Missouri has the highest number of major river bridges in the nation, with 53 bridges.
