V-Bed Removal Tool

Description

Standard spreader racks and the hooks on the tie-down straps were redesigned for easier and faster installation and removal of spreaders.



Benefit

Operators can install or remove a spreader in a fraction of the time needed with a standard setup. The reach tool allows the process to be completed without having to climb the sides of the truck.

Parts and Labor

16 ft. $-\frac{3}{8}$ " chain	\$21
$4 - \frac{3}{8}$ " chain hooks	\$16
4 – 21" tarp straps	\$7
8 ft. $-\frac{5}{16}$ " round stock	\$5
$4 - \frac{3}{8}$ " bolts and nuts	\$1
8 in. – 1" square tubing	_\$2
Total	\$52
Labor	4 hour

Note: Facilities with existing spreader racks will not need to purchase chains or hooks. Tarp straps must be replaced annually.
